President Melton reported things have been moving along reasonably smoothly. He mentioned District 1 had several power outages and reported no loss of equipment during that time.

Ms. Horton provided a written Customer Service and Operations Report. Ms. Horton discussed the Pumping Data. She reported 66.7 million gallons was pumped for the month of July in Dona Ana, 5.7 million gallons for Ft. Selden and 15.9 million gallons in Picacho Hills.

Ms. Horton reported on the Pump vs Sold and reported a water loss of 13%.

Ms. Horton reported on the Well Data Update. She stated Well 7 has 95% of the materials on site and is scheduled to be online by September. She mentioned Well 15 is up and running and Well 5 is waiting on a sand separator which should be in by next week.
