IRISH SODA BREAD RECIPE

Recipe

- | | |
|--------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| ◆ 1 teaspoon salt | ◆ 1 teaspoon baking soda |
| ◆ 2 1/2 cups all purpose flour | ◆ 2 eggs (1 for egg wash) |
| ◆ 1 teaspoon baking powder | ◆ 1 stick salted butter,
cubed |
| ◆ 1/4 cup sugar | ◆ 1/3 cup raisins |
| ◆ 1 1/2 cups buttermilk | |

Directions

- ◆ Preheat oven 375°, mix together salt, flour, baking powder, sugar and baking soda, then add 4 tablespoons of cubed butter, mix until the butter is clumpy.
- ◆ In a separate bowl, whisk together one egg and buttermilk, then add to the flour mixture. Stir in raisins, and mix.
- ◆ Knead dough on a flour surface, shape into a round loaf and place on a greased baking sheet. With a sharp knife, place an x on top of the loaf and brush with a egg wash.
- ◆ Bake 45-55 minutes until golden brown. Remove the baking sheet from the oven. Melt 4 tablespoons of butter and brush the top of the bread.

UPCOMING PROJECTS-DONA ANA WATER TANK REHABILITATION

Our Engineers at Bohannon Huston, Inc. have completed the preparation and planning for the recovery of the four Dona Ana Water tanks which are approximately 20-35 years old. The tanks will be sandblasted and recoated with an epoxy-based covering for the inside, and a polymer-based covering for the outside surface. These tanks supply water to more than 4,000 homes in our area. The construction portion of this project is being funded by the Water Trust Board in the amount of \$2,550,000. The project is currently in the bidding phase. Please see our website at dawater.org for all updates on this project.

CONSTRUCTION

We have two upcoming projects expected to start construction late March or early April, 2022.

- ◆ Dona Ana MDWCA Parking Lot Improvement-To increase membership parking and provide more accessible handicap parking.
- ◆ Dona Ana Village Liftstation and Forcemain-Rehab of the existing lift station, force main and related infrastructure is the focus of this project. This wastewater system is the foundation for our wastewater infrastructure. Funding for this project is through New Mexico Finance Authority Colonias Infrastructure Board.

We ask our customers to watch out for all heavy equipment, orange barrels, flaggers, construction workers , and Dona Ana MDWCA employees. Please be cautious and remember to drive slow and comply to all construction signs for your safety and for the safety of the construction workers. WATER RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available in the Doña Ana MDWCA water service area for the exclusive use of a single metered family residence for domestic purposes. Service to buildings attached to the residence, including garages and other minor buildings for the use of the residents, may also be through the residential meter. Service to a residence, which is used in part for commercial purposes, but the predominant usage is for residential purposes, shall be served under this rate schedule.
